Dear East End Community Members,

Thank you for all the love and support in 2020 which was one of the most trying and unique years of this era. The 45th year since the inception of East End United Community Center was certainly a test in resiliency. A test that was passed with flying colors thanks to the amazing hard work and generosity of our staff, volunteers, donors, participants, and partners.

While adapting to the challenges of the pandemic, in some ways we were able to expand on services and programs. EEUCC provided thousands of meals and emergency relief supplies to those in need in our community. Our truancy department assisted a full caseload of students, and afterschool and summer school programs served hundreds of students. We made new partnerships, initiated one-time fundraisers, and continued to grow as an organization.

In looking ahead, we will continue to provide new and unique opportunities for the children in our community through grant funding geared to students with hands-on learning opportunities: Gardening, cooking, and traveling will all be explored. Throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, East End United Community Center has been the recipient of an outstanding amount of support from our community. We began the pandemic by raising funds through our 24 Hour Run, ran by Julio Palma. In this run, Palma raised nearly \$10,000. As we remained open to continue being a resource for the East End Community, we provided much needed relief through funds provided by Baltimore Life and the Southwestern PA United Way. These grants allowed us to provide our community members with cleaning supplies and toiletries such as dish soap, deodorant, body wash, shampoo, conditioner, bleach, paper towels, toilet paper, and much more! In addition to supplies, we provided thousands of hot meals and snacks each week to our community. We moved afterschool programming to a virtual platform and provided chromebooks to children without computers at home.




