And, as always, the amazing hard work and generosity of our staff, board members, volunteers, donors, participants, and partners made it possible.

While the pandemic certainly provided challenges in 2021, we were ready to adapt. EEUCC continued to provide thousands of meals and emergency relief supplies to those in need in our community, but now also did so through a monthly food pantry. We served hundreds of students through our daycare, truancy mitigation services, and out-of-school time programming and were able to resume field trips and conduct weekly cooking classes. We made new partnerships, initiated fresh programs, and continued to grow as an organization.

In looking ahead, we will continue to offer unique opportunities for the children and families in our community through grant funding geared to students with hands-on learning opportunities. Gardening, grief support groups services, and financial and career education classes are some of the initiatives in which groundwork was laid in 2021. And we will renovate our community center to expand programming.


Before Connect to Classrooms, Nicole chose to get into the truancy alleviation profession because she likes children and wants to assist in keeping them in school to receive a proper education.
